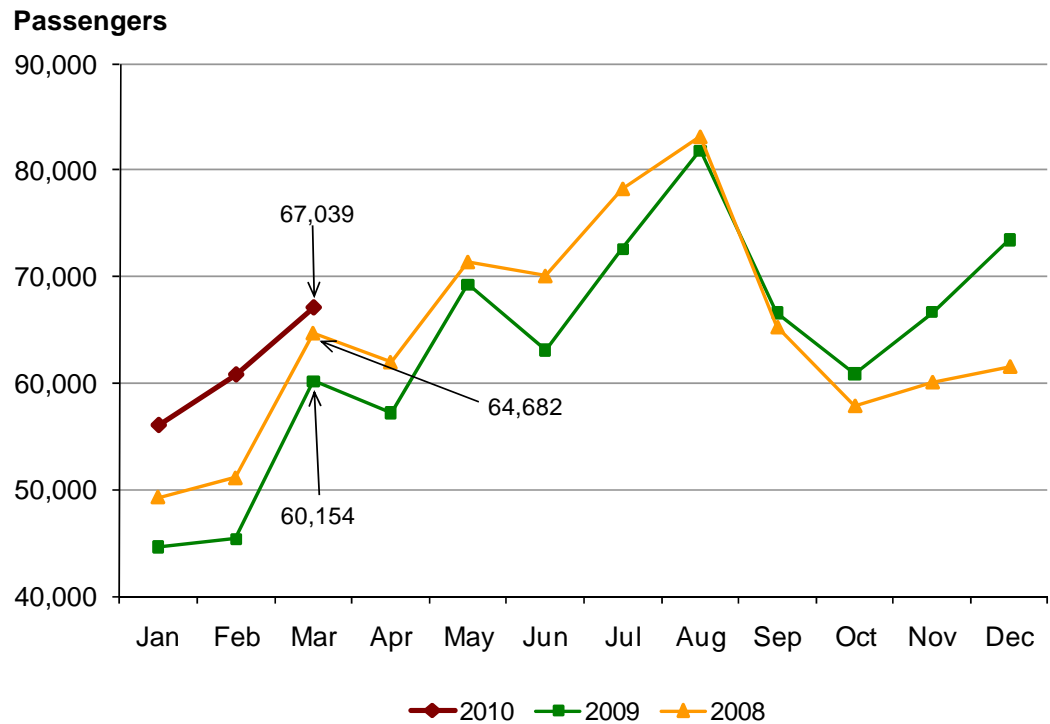


## Amtrak Cascades Monthly Ridership Report – March 2010
