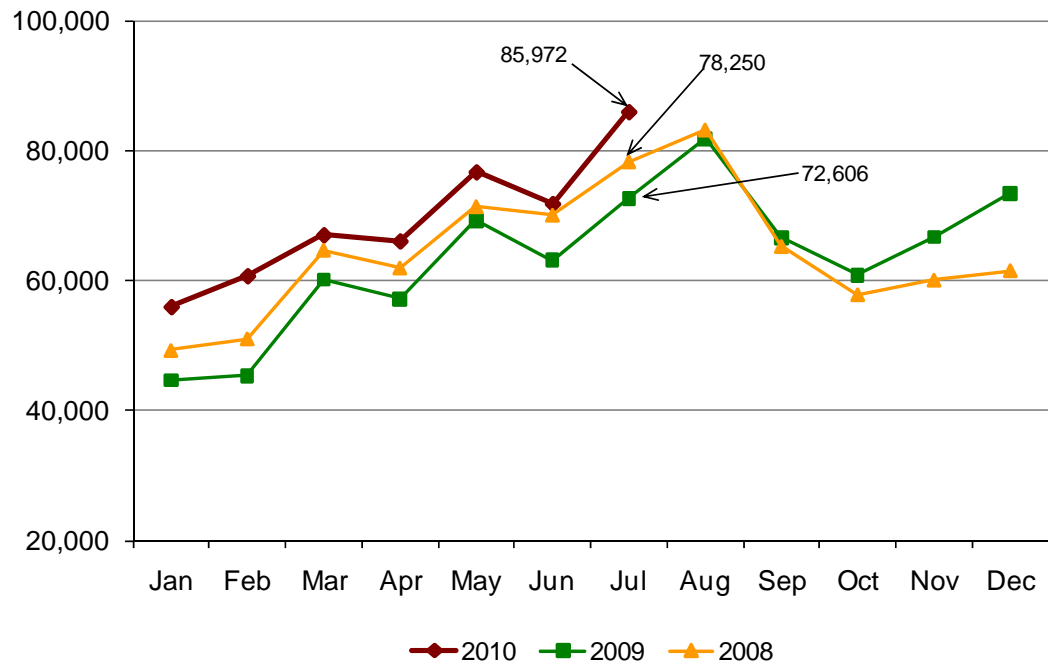


Amtrak Cascades Monthly Data Ridership Report – July 2010
